# HASKELL COUNTY APPRAISAL DISTRICT ANNUAL REPORT 2022

The Haskell County Appraisal District is a political subdivision of the State of Texas. The provisions of the Texas Property Tax Code govern the legal, statutory, and administrative requirement of the appraisal district. The members of the Board of Directors are elected by the taxing units within the boundaries of Haskell County and must live within the district two years prior to serving on the board. The Chief Appraiser is appointed by the Board of Directors and is the chief administrator of the appraisal district. The appraisal district is responsible for local property tax appraisal, valuation, property tax collections and exemption administration. The local taxing units such as the county, schools, cities, emergency service district and groundwater conservaton district set tax rates that allow for maintenance and operation of the entity. The Haskell CAD serves the following taxing units:

The district maintains approximately 13,000 parcels of various types that include: residential, commercial, business personal property and exempt property. We have approximately 4000 mineral, industrial, industrial personal property, and utilities accounts that are outsourced for valuation to Pritchard and Abbott, an independent appraisal firm.

**Exemption Data:** The law allows for the following exemptions to be offered to the taxpayers: homestead, over 65, disabled person and disabled veterans exemptions. The land included under a homestead may not exceed 20 acres and is normally the land utilized as a yard. You may only apply for homestead on one property in a tax year. The qualifying criteria to obtain a homestead exemption are:

~ you must own and reside in the home

~ you must provide a copy of your drivers license or state issued identification card and the address must match the physical address of the residence in question

Owners can file this application once ownership is filed & all qualifications are met. Taxes may be prorated if you do not own your home as of January 1 in that year. You may file a late homestead exemption if you file it no later than one year after the date taxes become delinquent.
